Functional Capacity Evaluations (FCE)

What is an FCE? A Functional Capacity Evaluation objectively measures an individual's <u>physical abilities</u>; this assists doctors, insurance companies, and employers in determining a person's potential to return to the workforce after injury; or their overall disability rating.

What does it entail?

The client is placed through a series of tests over a 3-4 hour period that help the evaluator determine what the client's present physical abilities and inabilities. A detailed report is generated and this is used to help insurance adjusters and physicians determine disability ratings. It also allows employers to find an employee an appropriate position in the company, if available.

The test and report includes:
